Ingham Institute Men's Health and Cancer Research Grant

The Ingham Institute invites applications for Men's Health and Cancer research grant funded by targeted charitable donations by Institute's supporters acting through Narellan Rotary.

The total amount available this year is \$55,000 and it can be awarded as one or more grants.

Applications should be written in lay language, limited to four A4 pages and include:

- Title of the project
- Investigators
- Description of the aims, proposed outcomes and methods
- Project timeframe
- Indicative budget

Applicants are encouraged to:

- a) involve more than one research group in the Institute and/or;
- b) increase research capacity and/or;
- c) support the development of a larger competitive grant proposal.

Conditions:

1. The grant is open to Ingham Institute staff and affiliated researchers with a signed MOU with the Ingham Institute.
2. The work must be performed at the Ingham Institute.
3. Chief Investigator A should be less than seven years from completion of their first Higher Degree.
4. Maximum of two Chief Investigators per grant application.
5. The minimum application amount is \$10,000.
6. Funding will be credited to a cost centre within the Ingham Institute accounting system.
7. A report on grant outcomes is required by 31 January 2021 with grant funds expended or fully committed. Unspent and uncommitted funds will be claimed back.
