Leading the spirit of generosity was an incredible \$300,000 donation from the Vitocco Charitable Foundation. Natalie Barr, newsreader and media personality from Channel 7's Sunrise, returned as Master of Ceremonies for the fourth year running. The Phantom of the Opera theme was officially set by the awe inspiring talent of Dale Burridge, who wowed the audience as he sang the greatest hits from his famous musical. Guests were also treated to comedian Simon Kennedy, who kicked off his performance with an impressive impression of Sunrise's David Koch, much to the amusement of Natalie Barr.

This year, the researcher in focus was Professor Afaf Girgis AM, Director of the Institute's Psycho-oncology research group which focuses on cancer support programs. Professor Girgis spoke about the work of her group in researching the well-being and supportive care of cancer patients and their caregivers. She focused on the groups' Coping Together program which provides communication and coping strategies for the mental, emotional and physiological aspects of the disease as well as their iConquer Fear program, which targets specific concerns in present and post-cancer patients such as cancer reoccurrence.

RESEARCH FOCUS: CANCER SUPPORT PROGRAMS

The Institute's cancer research programs extend beyond biology and looking for a cure for the disease.

Our **Psycho-Oncology Group** focuses on cancer patients and their carer's welfare and wellbeing by providing cancer support programs including communication tools for partners and carers. The group is led by **Professor Afaf Girgis AM** who has worked for over 30 years as a Behavioural Scientist in cancer control and psycho-oncology.

Coping-Together is an innovative coping skills intervention program designed for patients and their partners, incorporating current, evidence-based strategies for illness self-management and coping. The team also developed a series of booklets and DVDs.

The **PROMPT-Care** (Patient-Reported Outcome Measures for Personalised Treatment and Care) e-health platform empowers people to provide direct feedback on their care to their clinicians in real time, ultimately improving the quality of the care they receive. It captures a patient's symptoms, distress and unmet needs.




